The world over, children always bear the greatest brunt of any crisis. The need has never been more urgent for children across the globe than it is today.

From my own personal experience as a child growing up in communist Bulgaria, I know that Jesus gives light and hope in the darkest of times.

I was 5 years old when my father was brutally taken away. My family suffered greatly, not knowing if we would ever see him alive again. Because my father was falsely convicted as a "spy" and "an enemy of the socialist state of Bulgaria," my mother was forbidden to work. I know what is means to be hungry and hurting.

That is why this summer I want to bring light and hope to children living in dire circumstances.

Erbil, Iraq: Summer School for Syrian Refugees

The Syrian civil war that began in 2011 displaced 5.6 million refugees. About half of whom are children - little ones that still remember the trauma of war. These children's lives have been turned upside down while living in exile.

For several years, Door of Hope International has supported a school in Erbil, Iraq, that provides schooling to 50 children of Syrian refugees with a Christian-based curriculum.

The Covid-19 pandemic placed severe limits on the number of children who could attend our school. Because of these limits, many have fallen behind in their studies. This summer our teachers will hold a special summer school program to allow those children who fell behind to catch up.

Pleven, Bulgaria: teen mission camp

Camp Pleven is a summer program that provides Bible and missions teaching to around 50 teenagers from all backgrounds across the country to study the Scriptures, worship and fellowship together. They receive discipleship training how to share their faith with others through testimonials, and street evangelism by performing Gospel message skits in public spaces. Many of these youth come from impoverished Christian families and need financial help to attend.

Emmanuel Camp, situated in the forests along Ukraine's beautiful Dnieper River, provides opportunities for children and youth. Days begin with morning devotion, and end with evening Bible studies. During the day the youth and children will have a chance to play sports, swim, go boating and hiking – events they have never experienced and can only dream about. They will learn important survival skills, as well as practical life lessons, including how to apply Bible principles to life's sometimes-unpredictable challenges. You can make it possible for an underprivileged child, many from non-Christian homes, attend this 10-day camp.
